Morgan Hill Police Department realigned our practices and vision with the six pillars of 21st Century Policing.

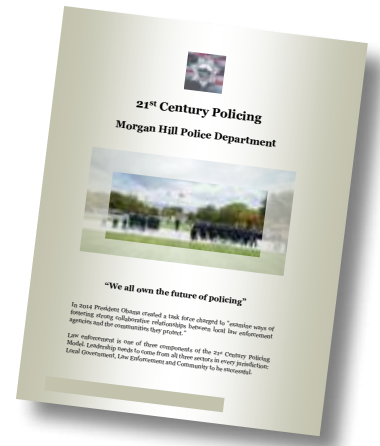
The six pillars represent:

- Technology & Social Media

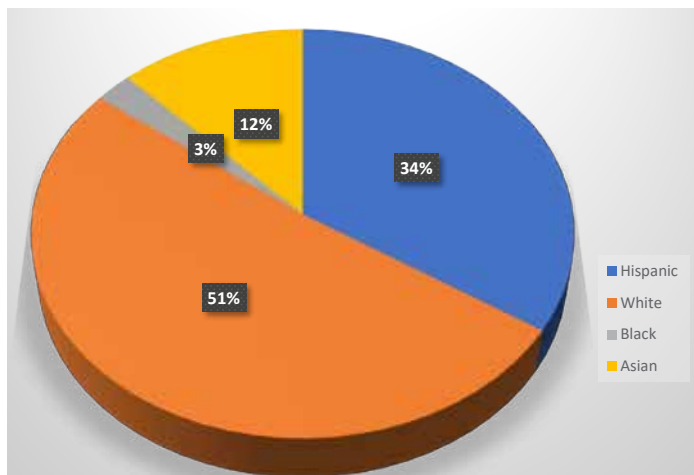
- Community Policing & Crime Reduction

POLICE REFORM EFFORTS

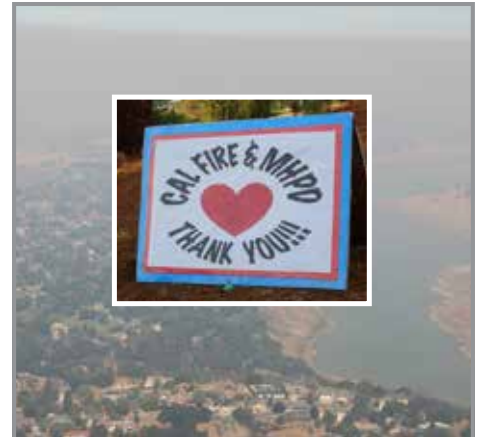
- MHPD partners with clinicians from the County Mobile Crisis Response Team to provide crisis intervention services
